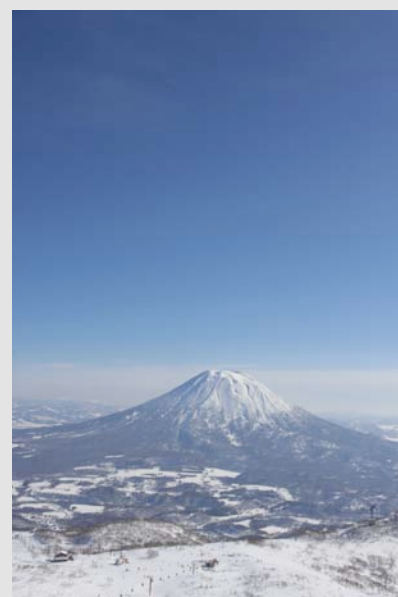

The Progression Camp is the only camp of it's type in the world that gives you extensive access to back-country booters and jumps. Our qualified coaching staff knows the best spots to build jumps for all abilities in Niseko's world famous backcountry terrain.

You get to try all your new tricks into deep powder before you take it to the park (Niseko gets well over 15m of snow each year). It's something that you will never find on any other camp program!



5 mountains, 4 terrain parks, and half-pipe

Don't spend all your time on the one mountain, 'jump site' or terrain park when at Niseko you have access to 5 mountains, 4 terrain parks, countless back-country booters and a regularly groomed half-pipe.

Each of the parks offer something different. There's a park specifically for skiers and riders new to jumping and jibbing, an intermediate park, right up to the advanced Hanazono Quicksilver park with huge tables, a bus, boxes and rails

The Camp are the first camp operators in the world to have taken a pro active role in educating campers about the potential risks involved with back-country travel, by offering recreational avalanche courses. The course will give you the fundamental knowledge on how to deal with avalanche terrain, the common do's and don'ts, and is recognized by the Canadian Avalanche Association – the world's leading avalanche research body.

Only dedicated freestyle camp

The Super and Progression Camps are Australia's only dedicated freestyle ski/snowboard camp. Our focus is solely on freestyle related skiing and riding. All our staff are freestyle coaches (not just regular instructors) and all our staff regularly compete in freestyle competitions around the world. From rails, pipe, big-mountain, boarder-cross, powder and jumping, we've got you covered.

Industry sessions

Learn more than skiing or riding – get to know off-snow aspects of the industry!

We are the only camp that takes you through the 'behind the scenes' aspects of the industry, including physical preparation, video editing, photography, approaching sponsors, avalanche awareness, and equipment maintenance and tuning.



More video analysis

The Progression Camp has added more video analysis gear this year to the kitty. This all means better access to your video footage. You will get to check out and analyse everything you do with the coaching staff, and even put your own video together with our full-featured video editing equipment.

Coaching

The enthusiasm and enjoyment of all participants involved in The Progression Camp is what makes it such a positive and unforgettable experience. All of our participants are here because like you, they want to develop their skills, learn new things, meet new friends, experience a different culture and most importantly, have a good time doing it!

Throughout the Progression Camp, our training is based around a program that is devised to fast track your development as a boarder or skier, without running the risk of burning you out. At the start of The Progression Camp we will ask you to identify your strengths and weaknesses, as well as the goals you wish to achieve during your stay. All of The Progression Camp's full-time coaches are fully qualified instructors, and have freestyle coaching credentials. They have been specially chosen for their ability to teach campers of all levels. They are more than equipped to help you get the most out of your riding.

Industry Education Seminars

Want to learn more about the snowboard and ski industry?

The Progression Camp was the first camp in the world to introduce our revolutionary 'industry education seminars' which are aimed at developing campers' off-snow knowledge in the ski and snowboard industries.

We understand that there is more to snowboarding and skiing than just the time that you spend on snow. The Progression Camp's experienced coaches regularly sit down and conduct sessions that focus on the following:

- Equipment maintenance and tuning.
- Avalanche awareness
- How to become involved in competitions
- How to edit together your own ski/snowboard video

The sessions are voluntary and everyone has the choice to join in on any of these free sessions during the program. If there are any other topics you would like to here about, please be sure to let us know.

Housing and Food

Don't spend your time sitting in a hotel room with just a TV and fending for yourself!

Moiwa Lodge is a traditional large Japanese ski lodge, with 4 stories of facilities, including: dinning hall, ski room, drying room, TV and DVD in each room, large communal areas, wireless internet, and games area. At the end of a long day, campers can come home and unwind by watching the latest ski/snowboard films, playing X-box or ping-pong, watching and editing their day's riding with coaches, waxing their gear for the next day's riding, staying in touch with family and friends via the internet, or just relaxing.



The lodge has many of the mod-cons, but still has the cool Japanese feel that you come to Japan for. During your stay at The Moiwa Lodge you will stay in separate male/female bunk accommodation. Each room has its own TV, DVD and mini fridge.

Moiwa Lodge provides a fantastic base to explore the area. Roll out of bed, put your gear on, and you have powder out the door. There is no better place to experience all that a Japanese winter has to offer ... endless snow, fantastic terrain, great food and amazing people.

Throughout the Progression Camp, breakfast and dinner are provided, and you have access to a range of healthy and nutritious snacks at all times. No one ever goes hungry. We make sure that you are eating plenty of nutritious, healthy and tasty food. You will be given two delicious meals a day, and if hunger still prevails, there's a 'snack cupboard' with plenty of tasty treats you can help yourself to.

As Niseko is such a large area, lunchtime can come when you are up to 6-8kms from the lodge. It is a hassle to trek all the way back to base for lunch. For this reason it is far more convenient and cost effective to purchase lunch on the hill each day. Unlike other western resorts, the on-snow prices for food in Niseko are very reasonable - a typical lunch will be anywhere from approx. 600 to 900JPY (\$8 to \$11AUD).

Off snow activities

We won't let you get bored off-snow. We throw in a ton of activities for days off and your time off-snow. The best part is that they are all included! Here are just a few:

Snowmobiling, day trip to Sapporo and the Sapporo beer garden, Rusutsu and Kiroro trips, shopping, onsen (hot-spring), swimming, and our final dinner celebrations.

This doesn't even include the stuff we do at home, such as our X-Box challenges, ping pong, watching all the latest ski/snowboard movies, learning how to tune your gear - the list is endless, and we guarantee that you will NEVER be bored.

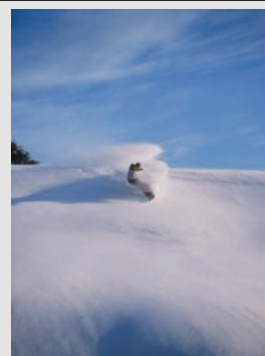

All participants and parents (for those participants under 18) must complete registration, medical, and code of conduct forms, as well as a liability waiver - these forms will be available in our registration pack, which will be mailed to you after payment of the deposit. It is your responsibility to ensure that the information provided in these forms is correct and up to date.

The Camp reserves the right to expel, deny registration to, or cancel any participant from it's programs at any time prior or during any program without refund. Any costs incurred thereof are the responsibility of the participant. **The Camp** reserves the right to change, alter, omit or modify any dates, programs or program details at any stage with or without notice.

Under no circumstances can **The Camp** be held responsible for snow or weather conditions, or be responsible for any cancellation or amendment by you on the basis of snow or weather conditions.

The Camp cannot accept any responsibility for losses or additional expense due to delays in air or transportation services, sickness, accidents, weather, strikes, war, terrorist acts, detention, quarantine or other causes.

Refunds:

The Camp will not provide refunds for any service or otherwise, for any portion of camp or tour payments. Itemisations or breakdowns of camp and tour costs will not be provided under any circumstances.

This refund policy does not apply for services that are expressly included in our guarantee.

Exclusions:

Unless otherwise expressly indicated, program prices do NOT include:

Airfares, appropriate travel insurance, excess baggage charges, customs duties, passport and visa costs, airport taxes, non-camp associated activities, STD or international telephone calls, equipment hire, any accommodations away from **The Camp**' program housing (if required), additional costs caused by weather, failure of transportation services, or any other circumstances beyond the control of **The Camp**, the tour operator or it's directors, employees, principles, agents or representatives. In the event of poor snow conditions, program organisers may choose to conduct extra day/multiday trips to other resorts at their sole discretion. Participants will be required to pay any costs incurred at these resorts.

Progression Camp includes 6 dinners per week. Transport arrangements can be made to local Niseko restaurants on other nights.

Transfers:

Airport and other transfers are free during scheduled arrival and departure dates. Transfers for Super and Progression Camp participants outside these times will be subject to a transfer fee per person for each transfer. Cancellation
